

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 41

The path is first shown on the first edition (1880's) of the Ordnance Survey 6 inch map, where it is labelled "FP".

- 2 It is paved for its whole length, has modern, Local Authority, street lighting and is well maintained. Metal bollards at each end prevent vehicular access. These physical details suggest that the route is public and is maintained by the City Council as Highway Authority, and is used by the public as a footpath.
- 3 The route is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- Since the path has been in existence for well over a century, is well maintained by the Council, is in use by the public, and is accepted by the City Council as being public, it is considered that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
