You will see there is a great deal of information included in the spreadsheet which should hopefully answer your enquiry sufficiently, however, it may be more beneficial if you were able to talk it through with one of our officers who would be able to explain the spreadsheet entries in more detail to you. This would enable you to get the maximum benefit from the information and allow it to be put into context. For example, the vast majority of on-licensed premises in Birmingham with a 24 hour licence very seldom use it to its full extent, and a good proportion of those have conditions which require them to give notification of their plans to open 'late' to the police well in advance.
