Birmingham City Council is encouraging all its customers who don't currently pay their Council Tax by Direct Debit to switch soon – and be in with a chance to win an iPad.

All Direct Debit payers – that's existing payers too – who have an instruction in place by 31 May 2013 will be in with a chance of winning the prize, which has kindly been donated to the Council for the purposes of this draw.

Well for us it means reduced paperwork – which saves money on envelopes, printing costs, and even cashiers and payment counters. 5. Customers who currently pay their Council Tax by Direct Debit are also eligible, and will automatically be entered into the draw, as long as their Direct Debit is still in place at the time the draw takes place.

6. The draw will take place in June 2013, by an individual not employed by Birmingham City Council.

7. If you are a winner, you will be notified by post. The judges' decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
