

2011 Census: Key Statistics for Birmingham and it's constituent areas

KS201, QS201 & CT0010

This table is part of the 'Key Statistics for local authorities in England and Wales', the first release of the key statistics that add detail to the population estimates from the 2011 Census of Population for England and Wales that were published in July 2012.

Further releases of these Key Statistics and the remaining Quick Statistics tables will provide the same detail for local areas when they are published in early 2013 for Output Areas and for wards.

Notes and Definitions

1. The main population base for outputs from the 2011 Census is the usual resident population as at census day (27 March 2011).

Although the population base for enumeration included non-UK short-term residents, these are not included in the main outputs from the 2011 Census, but are analysed separately. All outputs, unless specified, are produced using only usual residents of the UK.

For 2011 Census purposes, a usual resident of the UK is anyone who, on census day, was in the UK and had stayed or intended to stay in the UK for a period of 12 months or more, or had a permanent UK address and was outside the UK and intended to be outside the UK for less than 12 months.

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Definitions

Ethnic group

Ethnic group classifies people according to their own perceived ethnic group and cultural background.

This 2011 Census release provides tables with detailed information on the ethnic group of the usual resident population of England and Wales as at census day, 27 March 2011.

The tables QS209EW Ethnic group (detailed) and CT0010EW Ethnic group (write-in responses) supplement 'KS201EW Ethnic group' that was published as part of the Key Statistics for local authorities in England and Wales on 11 December 2011.

QS209EW expands the standard 18 ethnic group response categories. CT0010EW reports ethnic group write-in responses without reference to the five broad ethnic group categories, eg, all Irish people, irrespective of whether they are White, Mixed/multiple ethnic groups, Asian/Asian British, Black/African/Caribbean/Black British or Other ethnic group, are in the "Irish" response category.

They provide estimates for England and Wales and constituent regions, counties, London boroughs, districts and unitary authorities. Further releases of these tables will provide the same detail for local areas when they are published in early 2013 for Output Areas

Usual resident

The main population base for outputs from the 2011 Census is the usual resident population as at census day 27 March 2011. Although the population base for enumeration included non-UK short-term residents, this population is analysed separately and is not included in the main outputs from the 2011 Census. All outputs, unless specified, are produced using only usual residents of the UK.

For 2011 Census purposes, a usual resident of the UK is anyone who, on census day, was in the UK and had stayed or intended to stay in the UK for a period of 12 months or more, or had a permanent UK address and was outside the UK and intended to be outside the UK for less than 12 months.
